The project diversifies tourism offers in peripheral destinations with heritage-based products and services, addressing stakeholder alliances and improving professional skills to internationalize locally operating micro-enterprises, achieve excellence and facilitate their uptake by the global market.

Fully in accordance with the EU2020 Grand Societal Challenges and the new narrative for Europe, 2014, 7 peripheral destinations in the participating countries capitalize on best practices from the international

It enters the global distribution channel ITB Berlin in 2017 addressing primarily the connected consumer market, the senior and youth market.
